## GST WITHHOLDING SEMINAR

The Federal Parliament has passed legislation to introduce a GST withholding scheme. Commencing from 1 July 2018, purchasers of new residential premises or subdivision of potential residential land will be required to withhold an amount from the contract price and remit it to the ATO on or before settlement.

Developers will be required to provide purchasers with details of the amount of GST to be paid.

To assist your business prepare for the change, UDIA WA has invited Hoa Wood (Assistant Commissioner, Tax Counsel Network, Australian Tax Office) and Christiane Volaric (Risk Strategist in the ATO's Indirect Tax business line) to present an in-depth overview of the new procedures, how the change will be implemented and what it will mean for your business practices.
