Registration Details-

Guests can choose to book a yacht and come with a group to participate in the race, or can register individual tickets and watch the race from the Spectator's Craft.

Registration for a Yacht includes:

- A dedicated experienced skipper on-board, to instruct your crew as required
- 10 x places on your exclusive sailing craft
- Icebox with water and soft drinks
- 10 x tickets to the post race BBQ beach

Cost (inc gst) = \$3,500.00 by 31/10/2018 or \$3,800.00 from 01/11/2018 onwards

Spectator tickets include:

- A seat in the spectator craft with catering (drinks & nibbles)
- A ticket to post race BBQ
