You've applied

Within 9 months you'll receive a Design Information Package (DIP)

Due to the significant increase in application numbers from around 3,000 per year to more than 7,000 per year largely driven by various stimulus initiatives, we're experiencing unanticipated delays of between 6-12 months for some customer connection and relocation projects.

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We'll provide you with a Design Conformance Review within 7 months.

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You'll receive an invoice

Upon delivery of a completed Construction Administration Package including the completed ASCON drawing and receipt of invoice payment, a Project Network Officer will then be allocated and a handover meeting will be arranged within 4-6 weeks.

4 Handover achieved

Upon 100% quality assurance, handover will be achieved.

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
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The Objectives





Current insights

- ✓ Increased resourcing for DIPs and DCRs has seen increased output
 - c. 50 per month mid-2023
 - Average of 93 achieved Nov/Dec
 - Significant increase in January 2024 coinciding with new DIP process.
- ✓ Reduced Non-Conformance Rates.
- ✓ Quote Volumes consistently increasing during FY24
 - MP Projects/Land Development 50% higher than March 2023 qtr



New Initiatives Are Design Focused

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
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- Energisation Process Unchanged

What the New Clearance Pathways Are
